Diplomas For VIETNAM WAR VETERANS

CHAGRIN FALLS Schools, along with other Ohio schools have been allowed to grant a high school diploma to certain veterans of World War II or the Korean War who do not already have an Ohio high school diploma or a diploma of adult education. With the passage of Senate Bill 11, the provision is now extended to veterans of the Vietnam War. In order to qualify at Chagrin Falls, the veteran must be have been enrolled at Chagrin Falls and left prior to graduation in order to serve in the armed forces and have been honorably discharged. In the case of a veteran who is deceased, the diploma may be awarded posthumously and presented to a living relative.
